### CODE OF CONDUCT

- *Never exert undue pressure or influence over any persons within the club to obtain personal gain or reward*
  - *Never condone rule violations, bullying, rough play or use prohibitive substances*
    - *Respect each other's views, beliefs and abilities*
- *Above all, enjoy working as a crew and believe in each other, success is only an oar's length away*
